

C.V.S.C. Coaches Rules of Conduct

Our mission as a club is to promote skating through positive motivation, teamwork and respect for all.

The following rules shall govern the conduct and relations of C.V.S.C. professional coaches:

Coaches will at all times show the greatest respect for all professionals, skaters, club representatives and arena staff.

Coaches will recognize and respect the rights of skaters to seek instruction from the professional of their choice.

Coaches' behavior, both on and off the ice, will reflect an understanding of the influence they exercise over their students.

Coaches will use appropriate tone, volume and language when speaking with skaters, parents, arena staff and other professionals on and off the ice.

Coaches will conduct themselves in an appropriate manner towards all skaters.

Coaches will limit semi-private lessons to a maximum of 3 skaters/lesson. It is the coaches' responsibility to be respectful of other skaters right of way.

The Board of Directors of C.V.S.C. retains the right to withdraw any coaches' permission to teach on club ice at any time.
