



**Champlain Valley Skating Club's**  
**(C.V.S.C.)**  
**GUEST COACHING POLICY**

Coaches may Guest Coach on C.V.S.C. ice 6 sessions with proper current credentials in either of the following: US Figure Skating, Skate Canada or the Ice Skating Institute.

**For USFS:** due to the PSA/USFS CER requirements, a coach may present a copy of their valid Coach Registration Card to the ice monitor, along with a valid form of identification to be eligible to guest coach.

(If your Coach Registration card states "unavailable at printing", you will need to have a copy of your CER certificate of completion for either Category A or B; or provide a copy of your certificate for the actual courses that you completed (4 for Category A and 3 for Category B).

**For Skate Canada and the Ice Skating Institute:** you will need to present a copy of your current membership card (ISI/Skate Canada) and a copy of your current liability insurance.

Copies of these credentials must be given to the Ice Monitor on or before the first Guest Coaching ice session to stay on file with the Ice Monitor. Guest Coaches must adhere to the C.V.S.C. Coaches' Rules of Conduct (as given to the Guest Coach by the Ice Monitor on or before the first guest coaching ice session and as posted on the Club bulletin board). The C.V.S.C. Board of Directors reserves the right to deny/revoke Guest Coaching privileges.

If the Guest Coach wishes to continue coaching after 6 sessions, then they may apply to become a member of our C.V.S.C. professional staff.
